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Summary

A print-in-place, articulated doll with stitch details.

Back when I created my [Articulated Gingerbread People](#), I decided to create another version with different details.

The reason I decided to make it was because my daughter suggested I make the gingerbread man with black and white filament and I thought that wasn't very cookie-like but could be interesting as a stitched doll.

Joints have some bend, but not a ton.

The large prints in just under 4 hours. The small one only takes 1.5 hours.

I did a color change between layers to get the details different colors than the base.

You can add modifier blocks to put 100% infill at the joints but it isn't 100% necessary.
