Suggested print settings:

- Layer height 0.2mm.
- Infill 15%.
- No supports are needed but follow the suggested print orientation for ideal results.

Apply force to secure the components in position. Utilise the floor or wall as a support to push the parts in, and use adhesive if necessary.

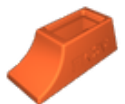
NOTE

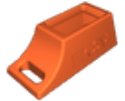
